

Board/Superintendent Prioritized Goals

The District will:

1. Effectively, accurately, and respectfully communicate and listen to all district constituents and staff members, to openly address concerns, improve district culture and morale and reach district goals.
 2. Develop grade level strategies for the Graduate Profile.
 3. Increase the availability and use of technology in instruction and analyze ways to provide access to technology for ALL students outside of school hours.
 4. Provide a seamless move for students from elementary school to middle school to high school both academically and socially; develop strategies to promote 9th grade success.
 5. Increase the percent of students who qualify for grade level promotion and percent of students who qualify for 4 year graduation; improve science scores.
 6. Ensure that open enrollment in Pre-AP and AP classes is continued and communicated; examine AP support programs like Springboard.
 7. Assess and prioritize facility upgrades; increase facility upkeep and curb appeal; examine high school cafeteria facility options.
