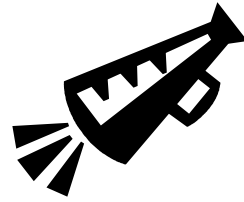

Important: Parents Please Read!

1. Little Cheerleaders will NOT be taught tumbling, stunting, or pyramids.
2. If you have a child with special needs, please call 830-795-6254 or email mbarnet@banderaisd.net to speak with the Cheer Sponsor. If your child is medically fragile, we may ask that the parent be present during the clinic.
3. Little Cheerleaders may bring their own poms, but we will have poms available for the girls and boys to practice with. These will have to be returned at the end of the 3rd quarter and at the end of each day's practice Tuesday and Wednesday.
4. Only those Little Cheerleaders that have participated in the Little Cheerleader Clinic will be allowed to cheer at the October 29th game.
5. In order to perform at the October 29th game during 3rd quarter, parents must be present at the game during the 3rd quarter for children younger than 4th grade.
6. At the end of practice and at the end of the 3rd quarter, the parents must pick up their children promptly, or the Bandera County Sheriff's Dept will be contacted.
7. Parents will only be allowed to take photographs or video from the fence. Parents may not come down onto the field (UIL rules).
