

# Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Charter

The male and female members of the Bandera High School Cross Country Teams submit for public record the charter of the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club.

## I. Purpose of the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club

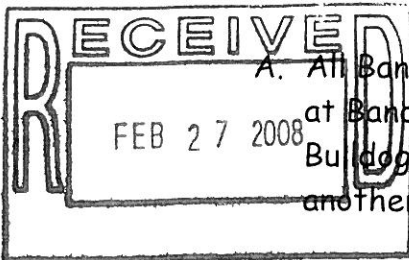
- A. To develop and promote ways to stimulate and increase interest and participation in Bandera I.S.D. Cross Country at all grade levels through a series of yearly track and field activities, including but not limited to cross country meets and cross country camps.
- B. To hold fundraisers, including a series of yearly cross country meets and camps.
- C. To collect and disburse funds, donations and reimbursements as required to supplement the necessary expenses encountered by the Bandera I.S.D. Cross Country Program, including but not limited to equipment, supplies, awards, travel, event training and adequate and proper instruction of cross country training, particularly when budgetary shortfalls occur in these areas.

## II. Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club Membership Requirements

- A. Membership in the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club is limited to Bandera High School male and female student-athletes, who in any given year, actively continuously and consistently train for the purpose of participating in the Bandera High School Cross Country Program during that given year.
- B. Membership in the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club terminates when the male or female student-athlete ceases to train and participate in the Bandera High School Cross Country Program, or when the student-athlete is dismissed from the Bandera High School Cross Country Program, or when that student-athlete is no longer enrolled at Bandera High School.

## III. Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club Meetings.

- A. All Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club meetings will be held at Bandera High School, unless catastrophe or Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club needs require that the meeting be held at another location.



- B. Two types of meetings of the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club may be called at announced times to be specified by the Bandera High School Head Cross Country Coach.
  - 1. Executive Meetings, which will include the Bandera High School Head Cross Country Coach or a representative of that individual and the officially elected student-athlete officers of the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club.
  - 2. General Meetings, which will include the Bandera High School Head Cross Country Coach or a representative of that individual and the officially elected student-athlete officers of the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club, as well as any qualified members of the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club who wish to attend the called meeting.
- C. All Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club meetings, regardless of the type of meeting will be called meetings, with the call for the meeting will be made by the Bandera High School Head Cross Country Coach or a representative of that individual, based on the needs of the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club, as determined by the Bandera High School Head Cross Country Cross Country Coach or representative of that individual in cooperation with the executive officers of the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club.
- D. The time and place of all Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club meetings will be announced in advance during the Bandera High School athletic periods and over the Bandera High School public address system during the regularly scheduled Bandera High School announcements.

#### IV. Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club Officer Selection

- A. Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club Officers will be selected through nomination and election by the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club general membership during the first semester of each school year.
- B. Election to any given office of the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club will be based on a majority vote of the Bandera High School Cross Country Club members who are present at the first general meeting that is held each year.
- C. The Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club Offices are:
  - 1. President, who will direct meetings in accordance with the agenda for any given meeting,
  - 2. Vice president, who will assist the President and Secretary/Treasurer as needed and direct the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club meetings when the President cannot be present at any given meeting,

3. Secretary/Treasurer, who will record minutes for every meeting that Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club holds and who will keep the other officers and general membership informed of the fiscal status of the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club, based on reports from the Bandera I.S.D. Business Administration Office, which will be obtained from the Bandera I.S.D. Business Administration Office by the Bandera High School Head Cross Country Coach or a representative of that individual.
- D. Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club Distribution of Funds
1. Distribution of Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club funds will be for items necessary to assure the proper implementation, organization, and instruction of cross country skills, techniques, and training by the Bandera ISD Cross Country Program as previously explained in Section I-C of this charter.
  2. Distribution of Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club funds for any given reason will be based on the majority vote of the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club members present at the Bandera High School Bulldog Cross Country Club when the proposal was made.
