BHS Freshmen Skin La Vernia Bears

Kyle Bauml also recorded an interception for the Bulldogs. The score was close until late in the game when an interception by Landon Ventura was returned for a touchdown.

The Bulldog trench warriors, Sterling Gardner, Nick Andreas, Alex Gonzales, Kyle Wilson, Nathan Thaler, Jarrett Lyle, Colton Gisler, and Shane Reynolds played well, opening up holes for backs Alex Willoughby-Gonzales, Landon Ventura, Noah Nelson and Luke Williams. The linebacking corps of Averie Mansfield, Landon Ventura and Luke Williams made tackles sideline to sideline for the Bulldogs. Defensive linemen Ty Fernandez, Wyatt Clemenson, and Austin Whalen played with good technique, controlling the line of scrimmage for Bandera. Receivers Ty Neff, Kyle Bauml, Brady Keane, Calvin Bankston, and Wes Joseph did a great job blocking the perimeter for the Bulldogs. Neff hauled in the longest pass for the day, a 25 plus yard strike from Nelson. The win improves the freshman Bulldogs' record to 4-1 on the season. The Freshman Bulldogs will be open on September 28, and will return to play on October 6 at home against the Wimberley Texans. Game time is 7:30pm.
