

HB 5 §39.0545: School District Evaluation of Performance in Community and Student Engagement

This statute requires districts to self-evaluate and assign to the district and each campus a performance rating of exemplary, recognized, acceptable, and unacceptable for performance in community and student engagement. By August 8, districts must report campus and district ratings to TEA and the public.
